Maritime Security Conference highlights European procurement: "Zeitenwende? It's all about Procurement!"

Ticket sales are now open for the **MS&D Conference 2025 – Maritime Security & Defence Conference**, which will take place on 25 November 2025 as a stand-alone event for the first time at the International Maritime Museum Hamburg.

With retired Admiral **Joachim Rühle**, former Chief of Staff at NATO's Allied Headquarters SHAPE, and Vice Admiral **Carsten Stawitzki**, Director General for Equipment at the German Federal Ministry of Defence, the conference has secured two highly respected and prominent figures from the military and defence sector as keynote speakers. 


