Hamburg Messe und Congress and Messe Berlin Asia Pacific announce cooperation partnership for future wind energy events in Singapore

Singapore / Hamburg, 16 January 2026— Hamburg Messe und Congress (HMC) is driving the Asian expansion of WindEnergy Hamburg, the world-leading trade fair of the wind energy industry, with the support of a strong partner. HMC has entrusted **Messe Berlin Asia Pacific (MB APAC)** with the local implementation of the new **RECHARGE Wind Power Summit Asia-Pacific powered by WindEnergy Hamburg** in Singapore. The premiere of the two-day event will take place at the **Suntec Singapore Convention & Exhibition Centre** and has been scheduled for 19 and 20 May 2026. In 2027 and 2029 respectively, a three-day **WindEnergy Asia-Pacific powered by RECHARGE** flagship fair will follow to cater for the growing wind energy market in Asia-Pacific.

Singapore is officially supporting the two organisers of the events, DN Media Group (RECHARGE) and Hamburg Messe und Congress (WindEnergy Hamburg), in staging the **RECHARGE Wind Power Summit Asia-Pacific powered by WindEnergy Hamburg** 2026 and **WindEnergy Asia-Pacific powered by RECHARGE** in Singapore in 2027 und 2029 through its government agencies Enterprise Singapore and Singapore Tourism Board. A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on these projects was signed during the RECHARGE Wind Power Summit in Hamburg in November 2025.

The decision to put Messe Berlin Asia Pacific in charge of carrying out the events in Singapore allows HMC and DN Media Group to benefit from their Berlin partners' existing team, infrastructure and know-how in Asia-Pacific. HMC and DN Media Group will remain the exclusive owners of the event brand and concept, while MB APAC will take care of event implementation and operations in Singapore.

As the owner of the globally-recognised WindEnergy Hamburg brand, HMC is growing its international footprint in cooperation with DN Media Group (RECHARGE) by creating a dedicated platform for Asia-Pacific, one of the world's fastest-growing markets for renewable energy, and in particular, offshore wind. The Singapore edition of WindEnergy Hamburg will provide a forum for government decision-makers, utility companies, wind energy equipment manufacturers and suppliers, project planners, investors and other industry stakeholders along the wind energy value chain in Asia-Pacific.

“Asia-Pacific plays a key role in the global energy transition, and Singapore is an ideal home base to address the entire region. We are pleased to work with Messe Berlin Asia Pacific to establish this new platform in Asia,” said **Claus Ulrich Selbach, Vice President Exhibitions at Hamburg Messe und Congress**.

"We are honoured to have been appointed as event organisers of the Singapore edition, and to support HMC in bringing the wind energy platform to Asia-Pacific. We are looking forward to our close collaboration with HMC and DN Media Group as well as regional partners to ensure a high-quality event for the industry," said **Katrina Leung, Managing Director & Vice President Asia Pacific at Messe Berlin**. Preparations for the **RECHARGE WindPower Summit Asia-Pacific** in Singapore have already begun. Further details on the agenda, exhibition and participation will be announced in due time.

About WindEnergy Hamburg (Hamburg Messe und Congress)

From 22 to 25 September 2026, WindEnergy Hamburg, the world's leading wind industry fair, will once again be the pivotal networking hub for experts, companies and investors from around the world: in eleven exhibition halls on the Hamburg Messe und Congress GmbH campus, right in the heart of the vibrant northern German port city, more than 1,600 companies from roughly 40 countries will present their innovations and solutions to 43,000 participants from around 100 different nations. Covering 80,000 square metres of exhibition floor, equipment manufacturers and suppliers representing all stages of the value chain for onshore and offshore wind energy will provide a comprehensive market overview. The new Energy Storage expo area, located in a hall of its own with roughly 3,600 square metres of floor space, will put the spotlight of the flagship fair on energy storage technology. The exhibition will be accompanied by freely accessible conference sessions where top-ranking experts will address the industry's key topics. Featuring more than 300 renowned speakers on six open stages, this free conference programme is organised by the WindEnergy Hamburg team jointly with its partners, including the Global Wind Energy Council (GWEC), the European industry organisation WindEurope, the national industry associations Verband Deutscher Maschinen- und Anlagenbau (VDMA) and Bundesverband WindEnergie (BWE), as well as leading industry media and enterprises.
